can sleep up to 28 people. The camp got its beginnings in the late 1940's as a fly-in fishing camp. In the 1990's logging roads brought Bluffy Lake Lodge the opportunity to be accessible by road. DIRECTIONS

Check your gas between towns!

- As you enter Ear Falls, please call us at (807)222-3225 so we can meet you in the Parking Lot.
- From Hwy. 105 turn right at Four Seasons Bait onto Goldpines Rd. (Hwy. 657) Go 1.5 miles (2.4 km) to Wenasaga Road
 - Turn left onto Wenasaga Road
 - Follow Wenasaga Road for 1 mile (1.6km) to South Bay Road
 - Turn Left onto South Bay Road
 - Follow South Bay Road for 10.5 miles (16.9km) to Gleave Lake Road
 - Turn right onto Gleave Lake Road
 - Follow Gleave Lake Rd for 7.5 miles (12km)
 - Follow signs for Bluffy Lake Lodge
 - Turn Right into Parking Area
 - **Park in Parking Lot to be picked up.** No private vehicles past lot. The last part of road is built on swamp so can only take limited vehicles.

FISHING PACKAGES

\$150 USD deposit per person is required for all fishing packages by January 15th. Deposits transferable or refundable for the current season within 60 days or more notice from your scheduled arrival. Gas not included. Includes 16' Naden boat with 15 hp motor – gas not included.

SIX NIGHT FISHING PACKAGES

Arrive Saturday after 8am and depart the following Friday morning by 9am. No split weeks.

MODERN LIGHT HOUSEKEEPING CABINS

BEAR DEN (sleeps 8)

NORTHERN OUTBACK (sleeps 6)

- Two bedrooms, shower, urinal
- \$795 per person. May through June 20th Groups of less than 4 ask for availability.
- \$765 per person for a group of 5 or more.

LOON INN (LOONY BIN) (sleeps 4)

- One bedroom, shower
- \$765 per person.

LIGHT HOUSEKEEPING CABINS

Equipped with hot/cold running water and use of central shower.

SKUNK HOLLOW - (sleeps 4)

- \$750 per person.

MOOSE LODGE - (sleeps 2 – Queen & Twin Bed)

- \$700 per person.

FOUR NIGHT PACKAGE RATES

Check-in anytime after 8am Saturday to Monday. Check-out before 9am on following Friday. No split weeks. No Friday check-ins.

- Bear Den/Northern Outback/Loon Inn - \$650 per person. May through June 20th groups less than 4 ask for availability.
- Skunk Hollow - \$600 per person
- Moose Lodge - \$550 per person

CHILDREN

- Ages 14-16 are half price of adult price.
- Age 13 and under riding 3rd person in a boat - no charge. Riding 2nd person in boat half price.

EXTRA BOAT/MOTOR (does not include gas)

- For a group with 4 or more adults, \$100 charge
- For a group of 3 adults \$150 charge.

HUNTING PACKAGES

BEAR HUNTING & FISHING PACKAGE

A \$1000 deposit per hunter is required for all bear hunts. All reservations are guaranteed based on deposit date. Arrive Saturday after 8 am and depart the following Friday morning by 9am. \$2200 Includes baiting. No return of deposit if cancellation is 60 days before season.

MOOSE HUNTING PACKAGE

A \$1500 deposit per hunter is required for all moose hunts. All reservations are guaranteed based on deposit date. We cannot provide guide services. No return of deposit if cancellation is 60 days before season.

- Adult Bull Moose \$4500 per hunt
- Adult Cow Moose \$3000 per hunt

Additional party hunter \$1500 per hunt

Price includes:

- Arrive Saturday after 8am (7-day hunt).
- Housekeeping Cabin
- 16' Naden boat with 15 hp motor (Does not include gas.)

ALL PACKAGES

FRIDAY NIGHT CHECK-IN (after 5pm) \$60 per person if available. Boats or minnows may not be available until Saturday morning.

MINNOWS Let us know if you need minnows.

EXTRA FEES charged for damages and unreasonable cabin cleaning and untidy requirements. Extra fees charged for unclean boats and damaged boats/motors/lost anchors oars.

NO PETS allowed.

INTERNET is limited daily wireless internet.

We reserve the right to change cabin reservation according to the number of guests.

No smoking in cabins.

Newer outhouses on premises. No flushing toilets.

Extra charge for LP deep fat fryers.

No early checkout reduction price. Final payment at end of stay. Cash or checks only.

WHAT TO BRING

Drinking water/beverages, food, bath/dish towels, soap, camera, insect repellent, sunscreen, sunglasses, toiletries, paper products (paper towels & plates), and snacks. Also bring clothing for all seasons including rain gear and hats/caps. Don't forget your fishing gear. We do have very limited life jackets if you need a life jacket. Also, you will need a current Ontario Outdoors Card and Ontario fishing or hunting license. You can also read regulations and get licenses online.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

All cabins are fully equipped with lights, propane range, refrigerator, electric toaster, stovetop percolator, kitchen dishes/pans, gas grill and bedding. Bluffy Lake Lodge runs on a generator with limited electrical output. For cabin safety, no electric deep-fat fryers, electric fry pans/ skillet, hair dryers etc. Propane deep-fat fryers and cast-iron pans are available. Electric drip coffee pots are available, but needs to be shut off when not in use and when you leave during the day.

We also provide minnow buckets for minnows that are sold onsite. No other bait sold onsite.

PLEASE NOTE: BLUFFY LAKE LODGE is a great Walleye and Northern Pike fishing lake. All Walleye over 18" and all Northern Pike over 27.5" are to be released unless it is to be mounted. Fish are measured from tip of mouth to closed tip of tail. Before there were limits, Bluffy Lake size and quantity of fish was very limited. The catch and release guidelines in place for the last 30 years has made Bluffy Lake one of the most outstanding, prestigious fishing lakes in the area. This is becoming common practice in Ontario.

Life jackets are mandatory. Guests under 16, by law, are not allowed to operate boats and motors.
